#### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Many parishes throughout the Archdiocese have received, or will soon receive, the final word on the merger or even the closure of those parishes. The next phase for those parishes is to implement the decisions. The parishes in that situation closest to our parish are in Sloatsburg and Tuxedo.

The parishes which are created after mergers and closures are implemented are called to collaborate with the other parishes in the cluster. Our cluster of parishes includes Sacred Heart; St. Boniface, Wesley Hills; St. Joseph, Spring Valley and the merged parish centered in Sloatsburg. Parishes in a cluster are asked to share resources and coordinate services as best as possible, beginning with coordinated Mass It will take many meetings with schedules. representatives from each parish to determine the best way to collaborate on the various issues. would seem, at this point, that most services would be offered in every parish, but there have to be ways to combine efforts and resources. Much more will be written and said about this as time goes on and decisions are made.

One thing I can predict at this time is a rearrangement of our Mass schedule with some reduction of the number of Masses. It is getting more difficult for the priests who provide assistance on the weekends to help as much as they have in the past. The three of us priests in the parish cover the extra Masses but there will come a time when the Archdiocese will not have three priests to assign here. Even now, the number of people who come to Mass can easily be accommodated in fewer Masses. Nothing will happen until the summer but we should be ready for some changes in that regard and other news on collaboration with our neighboring parishes in New York.

With God's help, there is nothing to worry about. The sacraments will continue to strengthen our faith and keep us strong as a parish family.
