Dear Parishioners,

I have a few different thoughts to share with you briefly in these notes.

First of all, Congratulations to all of the children and young adults who are graduating in these weeks. Today the 10am Mass in Church will be the Baccalaureate Mass for all those graduating from High School. Our hope is that our High School Seniors will know of the thoughts and prayers of all of us as they begin a new and important time in their lives. Off to college later in the summer or seeking to start new careers, our prayer is that they will always know that God loves them and is with them to guide them.

We certainly pray for all graduates whether kindergarten or pre-k or eighth grade or high school or college or post-graduate. At every age, our children need to know of our support and encouragement.

This week is also the last week for some Masses on the weekend schedule. As you probably are well aware, there will only be a 6pm Mass on Saturdays and one 10am Mass in Church from now on. I spoke at the 7:30pm Mass and the 10am Mass in school last week to explain once again the need for these changes. It would be great if schedules could simply remain as they are but in reality, there are so many things changing in the world and the Archdiocese that we also have to adapt. With fewer people practicing religion, fewer men becoming priests, with resources tighter for everyone, we truly have to change schedules a bit to better prepare for the future and continue to serve everyone as best we are able. Our priests are still here for you as is the whole parish staff and family. Our parish will still have more Masses than most parishes even after the reduction of two weekend Masses. I will write more about this next week, but I pray that we will all be able to adjust to necessary changes and stay close to Jesus in the sacraments. God bless.

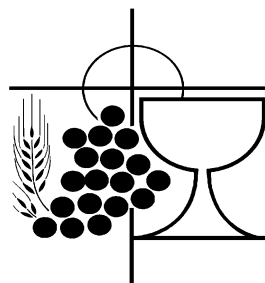
