"It was about trying to view and interpret realities, today's realities, through God's eyes, so as to kindle the flame of faith and enlighten hearts in times marked by discouragement, social, economic and moral crisis, and growing pessimism."

Much more will be written and said about the Synod but it seems to come down to trying to reconcile the Church's unchangeable teachings with modern day life. We pray for God's continue guidance and grace as we seek to do just that!
