A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

There is so much that I would like to write. I thought I had two more years as pastor here. That would have completed my twelve year term. Moreover, June 2018 will be the conclusion of the 150th anniversary of the founding of this parish. It would have been a great way (although still sad) to finish off my term. Rather, I am now starting to pack my things to report to a new parish as pastor by July 1st. (St. Patrick's, Yorktown Heights.)

Of course, I always knew my time here at Sacred Heart would come to an end. Actually I am grateful that I was able to be here a full ten years. There were times over the last decade when I thought I might be transferred much sooner. Since I reached the ten year mark, I sort of presumed I would be here for the next two years. We already have a committee working to plan the 150th Anniversary celebrations. Someone else will have to see those plans, or other ones, through to completion.

I have to say I am not upset to be leaving Sacred Heart. I am sad right now but not upset. The reason is that priests know we can be re-assigned at any time. Our bishop (in this case Cardinal Dolan) has to make decisions for the whole archdiocese. Sometimes those decisions cannot wait for a six or twelve year term to finish.

I remember when I left the United States in 1989 to join the Vatican's Diplomatic School in Rome. I really thought then I would never be assigned in the United States again. That was really difficult but I was ready to do it because I was asked by the Church. I consider it a "blessing" that I got sick in Africa and returned to be a priest in the U.S. Instead of going right to a parish, I spent twelve years on the seminary faculty in Yonkers. After those years, I had the blessing of my years here. I will miss all of you but I will always ask God to bless you, and I trust He will lead me in the next phase of my priestly ministry as He always has. His will be done.

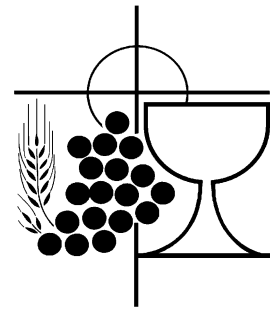
