A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

If you did not hear the news I shared at the Masses last Sunday, you will perhaps be as shocked as many of those who were there. Fr. Michael Moon has been appointed Pastor of the parish in Hartsdale, Sacred Heart. He will be leaving Suffern on July 1st, the same day I leave for my new assignment, St. Patrick's in Yorktown Heights. It is really quite unusual that the only two priests in a parish would leave on the same day to become pastors elsewhere. Yet, I think it is safe to say, these are quite unusual times. There are reasons for everything but it is hard to understand such an occurrence. We have to trust the decisions of the Cardinal and even more so we have to trust that the Lord is watching over us. After all, it is Jesus who is the head of the Church, and he provides shepherds for us in the persons of the Pope, bishops, pastors and priests. I think of how blessed this parish is to have Fr. Matthew Furey coming as pastor. Also, Fr. Javier will be returning for his 23rd summer here, and Fr. Benedict will return for his third summer here. In addition, as of June 25th Sacred Heart will have a new deacon in the person of Douglas Adams. Also, don't forget to pray for vocations, and especially for Walter Genito of our parish going into second year of major seminary. It is still sad for Fr. Michael and me to be leaving, but the parish will be taken care of.

We do not have word yet as to a replacement for Fr. Moon. I have a feeling it is taking Archdiocesan officials a long time to assign associate priests here and everywhere because there are so few priest to assign. Many elderly Pastors are retiring.

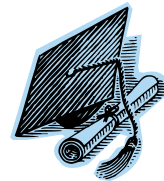

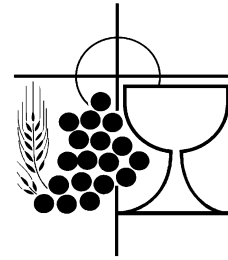
