A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

With the unusual weather we have been having, it is a bit hard to believe that Summer will begin later this month. The month of June also holds two traditional Catholic devotions. This Sunday is the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. This coming Friday we will celebrate our parish feast day, the solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Corpus Christi gives the Church an additional opportunity to thank the Lord for the sacrament of His Body and Blood. We profess our faith that Jesus is truly present in the sacrament of the Eucharist. After the 1pm Mass, we will have a procession with the Blessed Sacrament in the monstrance for all to see. I wish we could have a procession after every Mass but that would not be practical. Even if we cannot or do not join in the procession, we can pray that more people will come to know of God's love for us as He gave His Son for us on the cross and Jesus continues to make that sacrifice present in the sacrament of His Body and Blood. Just as He offered Himself on the cross, He offers Himself to us in the Eucharist. May the procession touch the hearts of all who see it, Catholic and non-Catholic alike.

Speaking of hearts, we praise the Heart of Jesus, filled with love for us and pierced for our sake. The Sacred Heart reminds us that the Son of God would stop at nothing to show us His love. The image reminds us that God became like us with a love that goes beyond the human heart. God wants to fill our hearts with His divine love.

These are special devotions that non-Catholics may find difficult to understand and which Catholics should see as ways to strengthen our faith. May the Body and Blood of Christ make our hearts more like the Sacred Heart.

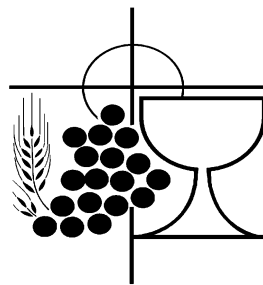
