### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This past week, along with many other pastors in the United States, I was sent an interesting book entitled: *The Four Signs of a Dynamic Catholic*. The author, Matthew Kelly, says that a rather small percentage of Catholics are committed and truly supportive of their parish. He uses a figure of something like seven percent of Catholics are Dynamic Catholics. It should be clearly stated that he says even Dynamic Catholics are not perfect and all Catholics can grow in faith and spiritual health.

Most interesting are the four signs he identifies: Prayer, Study; Generosity and Evangelization. Dynamic Catholics, he says, try to practice and live all four signs.

Prayer, of course, is extremely important, Jesus, the Son of God, prayed often and taught us how to pray, at least to begin to pray. Seeking to know and do God's will, following Jesus' example, is a key to prayer.

Study of the Catholic Faith is essential, especially in today's world. Many people think they know the teaching of the church, and nowadays even the mind of the Pope, from what they read in secular newspapers or see on television. Often the Catholic Faith is misunderstood or misrepresented and we have an obligation to learn what God inspires the Church to teach. Church teaching is meant to help us live the faith.

Generosity with one's time, talent and treasure is not something all people share. For some people, it is enough to come to Mass and not feel any other need to participate in the life of the Church. It is wonderful when a Catholic comes to Church for Mass but the hope is that the prayer of the Mass will spur us on to supporting the mission of the Church and helping our brothers and sisters in different ways.

Finally, Evangelization is helping to spread the Gospel message. This we can do by actions as well as words. "They will know we are Christians by our love." Living our faith will inspire others.

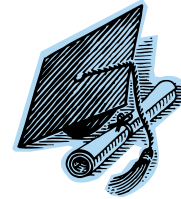
I just skimmed the book this week and I feel I have to become stronger in all 4 areas mentioned above. How about you?

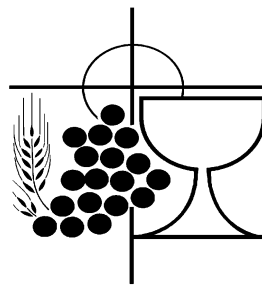
