Dear Parishioners,

You may have heard that the Archdiocese has informed me that Father Ginel is being transferred from Sacred Heart at the end of August. Neither Father Ginel nor I have received an official letter yet, but his re-assignment seems certain. This is one of many transfers of priests taking place this summer in the midst of a major realignment of parishes and priest assignments, and it is definitely the change that hits closest to home here at Sacred Heart. Many parishes are going through more changes than we are, but even small changes in Mass schedules take getting used to, as will parish life with not three but two priests for the foreseeable future. I actually think Sacred Heart will have only two full time priests from now on.

It is easy to be concerned or worried about the way the world is changing, and that includes changes in the Church and parish life. I truly believe that our parish is vibrant and we will be able to adapt to the changes we are experiencing. If we resolve to remain strong in our faith and come together for the sacraments, nothing will separate us from God's love and strength. Let us pray for one another. Of course, let us keep Fr. Ginel in our prayers as he prepares to change parishes. He is on vacation this month but he will be here for August. We will have an opportunity to bid him farewell just before he leaves. Pray also for an increase in vocations to the Priesthood. We need shepherds after the example of Jesus.

While you are praying, please say an extra prayer for Fr. Michael Moon and myself and all the priests who assist here at Sacred Heart. We have less help but thankfully we still have help. Finally, know of our prayers for you. May the Sacred Heart of Jesus keep us close to Himself always.
