### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Last Sunday I was thinking how good it is to keep some of the meaningful traditions of the Church. One hundred or so of our parishioners walked in the Eucharistic procession on Corpus Christi Sunday from the church altar, around the property to two other altars, and then back to church for the solemn benediction.

Traditions like this one help us as Catholics to remember how important are the many aspects of our faith. There is no gift as great as the sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. The tradition of carrying the Blessed Sacrament out of the church and into the world is meant to remind us that our faith is not simply something we live in church (although that is also important), but rather something we want to whole world to see. After all, if we live our faith joyfully, with God's help, people will see and give praise and glory to God. Perhaps someone driving by last Sunday or walking on Washington Avenue saw the procession and wondered what those people were doing. You never know what might make someone ask a question about our traditions, or even want to come back to the practice of the faith. God certainly has his own way of touching people's hearts.

We are blessed in this parish to have priests celebrating reverent Masses and ready to explain the Mass as well. The Cardinal, in his current column in Catholic New York, gives certain reminders about reverence and the holiness of the Eucharist also.

Once again, I simply state that I shall miss this wonderful parish. I am certain I will find faithful Catholics in my new parish, but I have a true sense of parish and family here, and it is not easy to have to leave. However, priests go where we are sent and we try to bring the Lord's presence into every place, especially where someone might not know Jesus or have forgotten him. Personally speaking, I can say that I feel I have received more blessings here than I have given.

Remember, Jesus is with us wherever we go. Let us stay united in prayer. God Bless always.

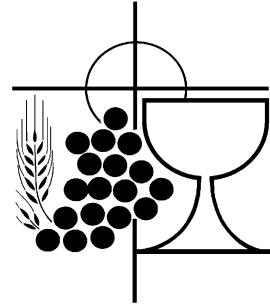
