A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

"This is the Day the Lord has made let us be glad and rejoice in it." These words arise from the heart on this joyous Easter Day, the Octave Day of Easter. And our joy is even more fervent here at Sacred Heart as our own Walter Genito, born and raised in this Parish, is being Ordained a Transitional Deacon this weekend (Saturday, April 7th) at the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C., the last step on the road to Priesthood next Spring. I will have the joy of being there to concelebrate the Mass in which Walter will be ordained, and quite a few of our Parishioners are driving down to be there as well to represent our Parish. Walter has also given me the honor of celebrating his first Mass as a Deacon later that evening at the Saturday evening Vigil for Divine Mercy Sunday when Walter will preach his first homily. We will have a special celebration here for Walter when he returns home in May.

What a beautiful and powerful Holy Week we had here last week with our Parish Mission and the Easter Triduum, culminating with the Easter Vigil and the Masses of Easter Sunday. Our Church was packed for eight straight days from Palm Sunday to Easter Sunday with countless numbers of people coming to Confession, many of whom were returning to the Faith after quite some time away. How grateful we are to Father Glenn Sudano for giving us this precious time and for infusing our Parish with such a spiritual charge. I also want to thank the Sisters of Life for singing at the 11:30 Mass on Palm Sunday and on Monday and Tuesday Nights of the Mission with music that was so beautiful and lifted the soul to Heaven.

One of my biggest fears is not thanking people enough for all that they do, and certainly all those who worked so hard to make our Holy Week and Easter here so beautiful. Thank you to Father Innocent, our office staff, our Choir, Cantors and Organist, Mary Peden, our Lectors, our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, our Ushers, and our dedicated Altar Servers. And it was so good to have Walter Genito with us who prepared the altar servers and guided them through all the Triduum Liturgies. And, of course, thank you to Henry Antonucci who once again worked so hard in preparing the flowers in the sanctuary so beautifully for Easter and in attending to

all the details of the Sacred Liturgies. I also want to thank Chief Clarke Osborn and the Suffern Police Department for having a police presence at all our Liturgies to ensure our safety. And a very special thank you to all of you for being here in such great numbers last week for the Mission and the Easter Triduum, and for your incredible generosity to our Parish and making it such a beautiful place to be all year long.

A major thank you that I saved until last goes to Christine Schnabel. In addition to all that she does here, Christine conceived the idea of having a Public Procession with the Cross on Good Friday and putting on a Live Stations of the Cross and Passion Play as a special event for our 150th Anniversary, and what a special and beautiful event it was. Christine worked so hard and put in so many hours in putting the entire event together in every detail. It was truly a heroic effort and was a great success. Christine never stops giving, way beyond her job description, and is the backbone to all that goes on here.

Everything we do here is for the glory of God who is rich in Mercy. Let us give thanks to Him on this Divine Mercy Sunday as we implore His Mercy *"in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world,"* as we pray in the Divine Mercy Chaplet, keeping that beautiful and simple Divine Mercy Prayer always in our hearts: **"Jesus, I trust in You."** May God bless us all.

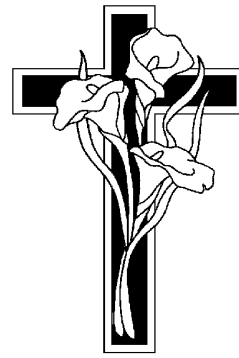
